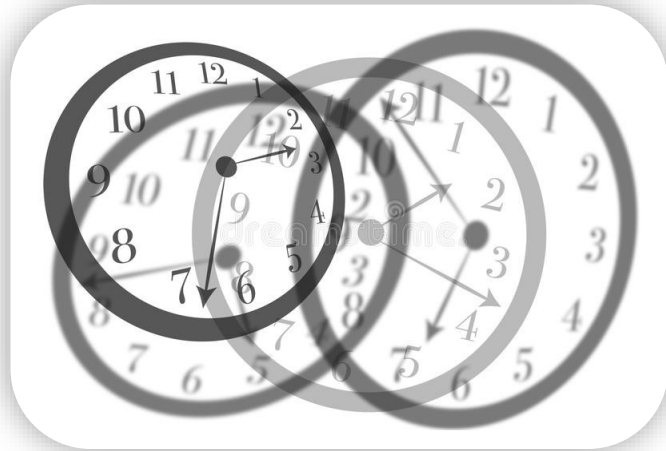
Passing With Time
