III John 1:1-2

Introduction

- A. If there was ever a religious doctrine that is against the will of God, it has to be the “Prosperity Gospel.”
- B. The “Prosperity Gospel” is a religious belief that financial and physical blessings are always the will of God for professing Christians.
- C. The “Prosperity Gospel” sees the Bible as a contract between God and man: if man has faith in God, he will deliver security and increase one’s prosperity.
- D. However, the Bible is not solely against man’s financial and physical blessings as the scriptures reveal.
- E. Today’s text is proof that the apostle John, and not Gaius for himself, prayed for wealth, health, and the “soul prosperity” of another.
