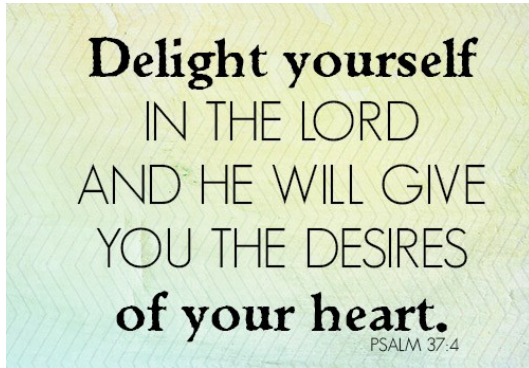
"1 This is a true saying, "If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work." It is significant that the importance of work has been described in so emphatic a manner. To be assigned to the oversight of a congregation is indeed a great honor, but that honor remains genuine only on the basis of effective effort. “2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; 3 Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; 4 One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; 5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) 6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. 7 Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.”

It is evident that these qualification do not just happen, but that they are the results of long years of consecrated living. One must remember his Creator in the days of his youth. It is good for a young man to desire earnestly the office of a bishop, and then to work zealously to be prepared.

Did You Know **Heart disease** doesn't happen just to older adults. It is happening to younger adults more and more often. This is partly because the conditions that lead to heart disease are happening at younger ages. February is Heart Month, the perfect time to learn about your risk for heart disease and the steps you need to take now to help your heart. Heart disease—and the conditions that lead to it—can happen at any age. High rates of obesity and high blood pressure among younger people (ages 35-64) are putting them at risk for heart disease earlier in life.
