by James McCaleb

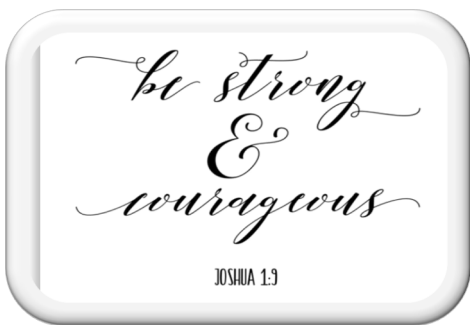
“Therefore let us also, seeing we are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, lay aside every weight, and sin that so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus the author and perfecter of our faith.”
