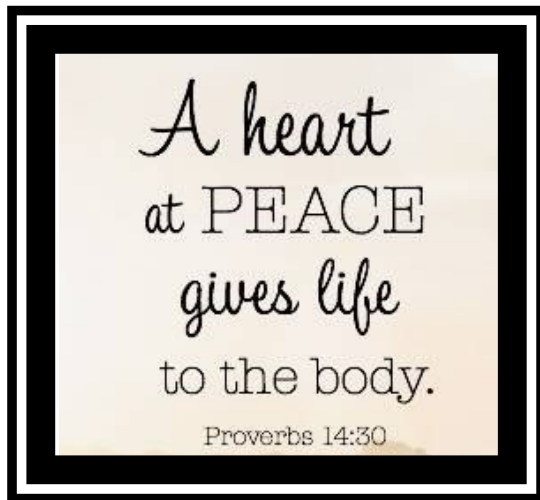

**“A Standard of Perfection”**  
by James McCaleb

Perhaps the greatest failure on the part of Christians is the seeming inability to demonstrate and to make evident those fruits of the righteousness that acceptance of the principles of faith must compel. It is easy to talk a good game but difficult to play it.

**“Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you....Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.”**

It is easy to understand why so many people spend a great deal of time in proving that no one can be perfect, and therefore one should not worry too much about the failings that are inherent in human nature. But God’s word enjoins upon us a perfection that is unattainable except through the power of Jesus Christ our Lord. One outstanding example is that of loving our enemies. That means that toward those who use us despitefully we must be always patient, kind, generous, humble, courteous, unselfish, and consistently good-tempered. Furthermore, we must look continually for the good points of our enemies: we must have hearts that hold no guile.

Christianity is more than a word. It is a change of life. The new life if possible only in the appropriation of the life that is in Christ. “Love your enemies.”

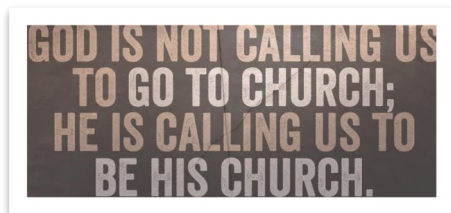
