Honest Work

Some years back, a certain well-known figure in public life addressed a graduating class of a school of higher learning. It was during the depths of the last great depression and jobs for the majority were not readily available. For the average young man it was a time of deep discouragement. The speaker chided them for considering themselves an "unwanted generation." He went on to say: "An unwanted generation indeed! What generation has ever been wanted? When has it been popular for youth to push aside more venerable age? When has it been the rule that the untried has gained his place merely by wishful thinking?"

Those words have remained as a challenge. There are no unwanted generations. True, conditions change from time to time, but there is room always for the individual who is willing to make his place in society. And that place can be attained only through the medium of hard, honest toil. God has ordained it that way, "And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground" (Gen 2:5).

There is something magnificent about honest work. Through it one gains self-respect and the respect of others. It is a common ground which all may share. Each one is limited only by his own will. And yet some will say that they are willing to work but cannot find the opportunity. I wonder if we should not pause to consider. Perhaps we are willing to work – a little – if everything suits us. That is not good enough.

The will to work must be present under all conditions. Furthermore, to be real, it must be demonstrated consistently over a long period of time. Too often a man condemns someone for not wanting him in spite of the fact that his entire previous history has been one of indifferent effort. The fact that he has changed his mind is known only to himself. It is apparent to one else. The man who will really work, and who has demonstrated that willingness, need never fear that he will not be wanted. That kind of person is all too scarce.

Surely we should not expect to offer to God a service that is inferior to that which is demanded by men, "And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts" (Mal 1:8); "And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him" (Col 3:17).
