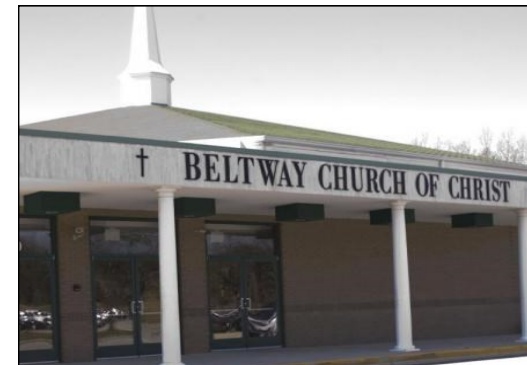

What Lack I Yet?

A young man came running to Jesus and said, “Good Master, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?” (Matt 19:16). Jesus said to him, “**...but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments**” (Matt 19:17). The young man said, “All these things I have kept from my youth up. **What lack I yet?**” (Matt 19:20). We need to ask ourselves the same question, “**What lack I yet?**” so we can be sure of going to Heaven. It would be a tragedy if we missed Heaven because something was lacking in our lives, or we needed to correct something.

We are told to “Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves” (II Cor 13:5). We need to look at our lives and try to see where we are lacking and need improvement. What can we do to be more pleasing to the Lord? In doing this we are told, “Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall” (II Pet 1:10). Any sin of which we will not repent will cause us to be eternally lost. Jesus says, “**I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish**” (Luk 13:3). *(next page)*

We need to beware of the false teaching of “once saved, always saved.” This is only a lie of Satan. Satan wants us to be lost. Satan doesn’t want us to ask ourselves, “**What lack I yet?**” We are warned, “Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall” (I Cor 10:12). Also we are warned to “Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness” (II Pet 3:17). Let’s not let Satan lure us into complacency. Jesus has promised, “**...be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life**” (Revelation 2:10).

To be strong we must regularly feed ourselves on God’s spiritual word in the Bible. We are to “receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls” (Jam 1:21). And “desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby” (I Pet 2:2). This will help us to have a strong faith to protect ourselves because we know that, “faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God” (Rom 10:17).

We must concentrate on what we must do to inherit eternal life in Heaven. And in doing this, “Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief” (Heb 4:11). We need to look seriously at our own lives to try to see any mistakes or failures we are making that could keep us out of Heaven, by asking ourselves, “**What lack I yet?**”

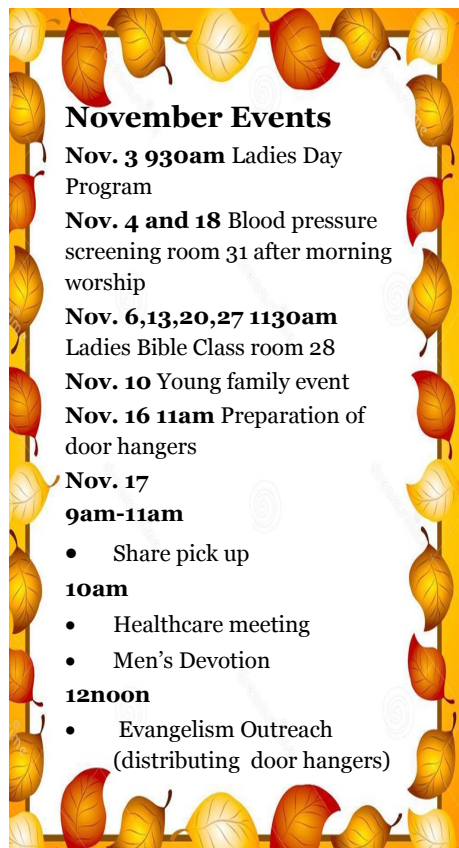

Introduction

- A. With the exception of Christ, it is difficult imagining a person taking upon himself, "daily, the care of all of the churches." But, this is exactly what the apostle Paul stated of himself in II Corinthians 11:28.
- B. And, in fact, the Holy Spirit provides a Biblical example of Paul taking upon himself, "daily, the care of all of the churches."
- C. Each church so identified by scripture, possesses Biblical autonomy; the right to self-govern itself according to New Testament doctrine.
- D. But when it comes to caring about other congregations of the Lord's people, autonomy is not limited to the local church!
- E. Thus, it is permissible for us to take upon ourselves, "daily, the care of all the churches" which inspired today's sermon, "I'm Concerned about Your Church."
