

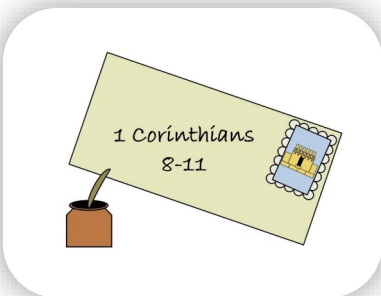

For Whom Christ Died

by James McCaleb

“I,” “My,” “Me,” and “Mine.” Those are among the first words that we learn. And that is not strange; for they are but the expressions of a natural self-interest. In the young we overlook these frailties of nature and consider them to be growing pains. As one matures, these same qualities bear more and more the stamp of selfishness.

“And through thy knowledge shall the weak brother perish, for whom Christ died?” (I Cor 8:11). In this quotation, Paul urges Christians not to use selfishly the liberty of superior understanding. He emphasizes with dramatic simplicity that Christ died for others as well as ourselves.

“For whom Christ died.” In a general sense, HE died for every man. “For God so loved the world that HE gave HIS only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in HIM should not perish, but have everlasting life” (Jho 3:16). In a specific and restricted sense, Christ died effectively only for those who believe on HIM and accept HIM within the framework of the faith. Surely, then, the fellowship of these sincere believers must be magnificent and wholly magnanimous.

“For whom Christ died.” That is an arresting thought. Truly one must strive earnestly, as a Christian, to prevent any human barrier from marring that fellowship. There is no more important person than the one for whom Christ died.
